Proposed Speed Table - Princes Avenue, Acton

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The London Borough of Hounslow propose, under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to construct a flat-top road hump (also known as a "speed table") in Princes Avenue, Acton, at its junction with Gunnersbury Lane. The flat-top road hump would extend across both sides of Princes Avenue and would measure a total length of 4 metres.
